Award

One (1) waiver of \$3,000 will be granted toward tuition for a Baking & Pastry or Culinary Arts program through the School of Food and Wine Studies.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Be enrolling in one of the Baking & Pastry or Culinary Arts programs during the 2010-11 academic year
- Be enrolling directly through Apicius and not through any agency or representative
- Meet all prerequisites and admission requirements for their program of choice

Awards

Up to three (3) waivers of \$4,000 each will be granted toward tuition for the following programs:

- Up to one (1) waiver for the Baking and Pastry Arts, Associate of Applied Science program
- Up to one (1) waiver for the Culinary Arts, Associate of Applied Science program
- Up to one (1) waiver for the Culinary Management, Bachelor of Arts program

Students must begin enrollment at The Art Institute of Phoenix by January 2011. Awards will be distributed \$1,000 per quarter. Students must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above at The Art Institute of Phoenix. The current quarter and future quarters' awards will not be distributed if a GPA falls below 2.5. Awards are not renewable.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Be a current high school seniors, high school graduates or community college students. Adult learners are eligible.
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale at the most recent education institution attended

Award

The award is renewable for up to three years (for a total of \$20,000) or until a bachelor's degree is earned, whichever occurs first, on the basis of satisfactory academic performance. Renewal is contingent on the recipient maintaining a minimum GPA of 3.2 on a 4.0 scale.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Meet admission requirements
- Demonstrate financial need
- Enroll full-time in a degree program

Up to three (3) waivers will be granted toward tuition for the following programs:

- Up to one (1) waiver of \$3,500 for the afternoon, evening or weekend Pastry & Baking Arts Diploma
- Up to one (1) waiver of \$2,500 for the Culinary Management Diploma Program

Awards are available year-round (all program durations are between 8-11 months and commence monthly)
