THE PROGRAM

Manning & Napier Advisors, LLC. has established a scholarship program to assist high school seniors in the greater Rochester, New York area who plan to continue their education. Renewable scholarships are offered each year for full-time study at an accredited four-year college or university of the student's choice.

This scholarship program is administered by Scholarship Management Services®, a division of Scholarship America®. Scholarship Management Services is the nation's largest designer and manager of scholarship and tuition reimbursement programs for corporations, foundations, associations and individuals. Awards are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, age, gender, disability or national origin.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants to the Manning & Napier Advisors Scholarship Program must be -

- ◆ High school seniors currently attending high school in the greater Rochester, NY area,
- ◆ Have a minimum grade point average of 3.50 (on a 4.00 scale) and a minimum combined SAT score of 1,800, and
- ◆ Plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited four-year college or university or an accredited two-year community college with intent to transfer to four-year school upon completion, for the entire upcoming academic year. All majors will be considered.
- ◆ Financial need is not a consideration.

AWARDS

Up to three (3) awards will be granted each year, one at \$8,000 and two at \$1,000 each. Awards may be renewed for up to three additional years or until a bachelor's degree is earned, whichever occurs first. Renewal is contingent upon maintaining a cumulative minimum grade point average of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) in a full-time course of study, and continuation of the program by Manning & Napier Advisors.

APPLICATION

Interested students must complete the attached application and mail it along with a current, complete transcript of grades to Scholarship Management Services postmarked no later than **February 21, 2012**. Grade reports are not acceptable. Online transcripts must display student name, school name, grade and credit hours earned for each course, and term in which each course was taken. Applicants will receive acknowledgment of receipt of their application. If an acknowledgment card is not received within three weeks, applicants may call Scholarship Management Services to verify that the application has been received.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, answer all questions as completely as possible. Incomplete applications will not be evaluated. All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by Scholarship Management Services and Manning & Napier Advisors.

SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, statement of goals and aspirations, unusual personal or family circumstances, and an outside appraisal. Financial need is not considered.

Scholarship Management Services will select finalists. Manning & Napier Advisors will interview finalists and select recipients. All applicants agree to accept the decisions of Scholarship Management Services and Manning & Napier as final.

Applicants will be notified in April. Not all applicants to the program will be selected as recipients.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarship Management Services processes scholarship payments on behalf of Manning & Napier Advisors. Payments are made in equal installments on August 15 and December 30. Checks are mailed to each recipient's home address and are made payable to the school for the student.

OBLIGATIONS

The recipient of the \$8,000 scholarship award must accept a paid internship with Manning & Napier Advisors during the summer between the sophomore and junior year in college. All recipients are required to notify Scholarship Management Services of any changes of address, school enrollment, or other relevant information and to send a complete transcript when requested.

REVISIONS
